



- 3) Mount box securely to joist or cross-member using (4) 1/4" lag screws provided. Use these screws only!
- 4) Use **only** supplied (2) #10-32 gold colored mounting screws with lock washers and sleeve for end of screw when installing the fan or fixture. Torque screws to 35 in.-lbs.






